Prize money:	60% of entry fees and sponsorship for all graded show jumping individual classes, Equitation and Dressage prize money dependant on entries & sponsorship
Entry fees:	SJ – as per the online entry on www.sashowjumping.co.za Dressage – R250 per horse per class. NOT GRADED Equitation – R350 per horse per class. Entry fees Include portion of R1500/day Paramedics levy, and all applicable discipline levies. Team Entry: R950 per team (Includes R16.00 per horse SASJ Recreational Show Levy)
Temp Membership:	R130 for pony riders/juniors, R350 for adults – non-members of the Durban Shongweni Club for the duration of the show.
Stable	R250 for the 1st night, R190 for additional nights per Horse, R125 for day use only (minimal bedding supplied as horse not sleeping over)

Notes: This Interschool competition is in no way affiliated to SANESA Schools.

- The organizers reserve the right to cancel, combine, limit or divide classes if necessary and if number of entries do not warrant the running of the class. In addition, the organizers reserve the right to change arenas should conditions or entries warrant the change.
- Show jumping entries will be limited to the prescribed practical maximum of 180 rounds per day on a first received basis. Dressage & Equitation entries will be restricted due to time available. Preference will be given to team riders.
- No Rider may compete on more than 3 horses in any one class.
- Please note that riders must state clearly which classes and grade they wish to enter. Changing from Grade/Classification to a lower Grade/Classification at the show is permissible at the discretion of the show holder. N.B: SUBSTITUTIONS OF HORSE OR RIDER HAVE TO BE COMPLETED AND SIGNED 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO START OF THE CLASS.
- Should the Substitution be Horse AND rider Substitution Form has to be signed by both old and new competitor and Substitution Form received by show holder 24 hours prior to the start of the show.
- All horses/ponies and riders must be registered with SAEF. Dressage will be run as a Recreational Show – Rider registration is free. If you are not a registered member of Equitation SA you may pay the required Temporary Membership Fee – R50 – but you must still register online at www.saega.co.za. If you are show jumping at 90cm or below, you only require to be a recreational member of SASJ.
- Should there be sufficient entries handicap classes may be separated.
- Entries out of order by closing date will be forfeit.
- Should the show need to be postponed due to weather or unforeseen circumstances, all entries will be carried forward to a new date. Should the show be cancelled for circumstances beyond the organizer's control, entries will be refunded less 20% admin fee

INDIVIDUALS RIDING FOR SCHOOL TEAMS: Competitors participating in School Teams must be entered in at least one of the Individual events for the same Discipline and enter on the Team Entry form as well. Individual entries must be paid even if entered in a School Team.

If your school has not received one please phone enquiries.

PONY RIDERS: Pony riders wishing to compete on their ponies for their High School may do so as long as the Rider is a registered learner in their High School i.e. Grade 8 and above.

Dressage: ALL DRESSAGE WILL BE RUN AS TRAINING CLASSES. I.e. NO GRADING POINTS APPLICABLE.

Pony Riders will be required to ride the relevant Junior Test in a 60 x 20 arena

Equitation: We will hold Pony Riders and Junior classes – the team riders in these individual classes will have their scores put forward to their nominated Team's score.

Show Jumping: Pony Rider, junior and Adult classes are on offer and will be considered as the required Individual Entry to qualify for Team Selection. However, the Team Event, will be run as per normal for horses - there will be no allowance for pony striding.

No Adult to ride any Junior/Pony Rider horse/pony entered in the show from one hour prior to the first class of the show until the end of the team jumping under penalty of elimination.

GENERAL RULES FOR SCHOOL TEAMS:

1. ALL Riders & Horses nominated to ride in a School Team MUST compete in the Individual classes of their Registered Grade in the discipline they are selected to ride the Team Event in. All Competitors participating in School Teams must enter on both the Individual Entry form and the Team Entry Form and each to be paid for separately.
2. ALL Riders representing their school in a school team must be pupils of the High School Section of their School. This is not a show for Junior School Pupils. i.e. Pupils to be registered in Grade 8 or above.
3. All teams are to be nominated & entered on the special Team Entry Form, signed and stamped by the Principal or person designated by the School. Competitors participating in School Teams must enter on both the Team & Individual Entry forms.
4. A Team shall consist of 4 riders/4 horses provided they are all pupils of the same High School. Or a minimum of 3 riders/3 horses from the same school. The best 3 scores will count towards the Team Results in all disciplines
5. Only one horse per rider per team (school) per discipline will be allowed
6. Schools may combine, provided they do not have 3 riders of a suitable level at the discipline in any one School. A combined School Team may consist of 3 or 4 riders.
 - a. All Dressage Teams must have their final team confirmation **1 HOUR BEFORE THE START OF THE COMPETITION** ON Friday 29th April 2022. Any changes made thereafter will be null and void
 - b. All Equitation Teams must have their final team confirmation by 07h45 on Friday 29th April 2022.
 - c. Showjumping Teams participating must be confirmed 15 minutes after the end of the last showjumping class on Saturday 30th April 2022, by the Chef d'Equipe at a meeting with the Show Organizers under the Judges Box - failing which the original School Entry will be accepted to be correct.
7. A School Team entering two or more teams please note: If a horse/rider in a Team is unable to compete, the 4th rider/horse from either of the Teams may change Teams. The change of rider/horse must be nominated 1 hour prior to the start of the event. Each rider may only represent their school once in each discipline – they cannot ride one horse in the A team, and another in the B team.
8. The order of riding will be determined by a draw done by the organizers.
9. Team Turn Out Competition & Parade is limited to ONE team of 4 horses and riders per school. It does not necessarily have to be the A Jumping Team – any 4 horses and riders can be nominated for the Team Parade so long as they competed together in a team event. I.e. The rider has to be in the team parade on a horse that they competed on in one of the team events. Please note that the organizers require a list of these horses and riders for the announcer – this must be handed in during the show on Saturday 30 April.
10. In support of fair play we encourage schools NOT to purchase new tack for this event. The judges will be looking for tack that is well cared for and correctly fitted!

PROPOSED SCHEDULE OF CLASSES AND EVENTS

FRIDAY 29th April 2022 – DRESSAGE (ungraded)

Open to Adults & Juniors & Pony Riders. Registration with DSA not compulsory.

Riding up or down a grade is NOT permitted with the exception of Medium Horses that may ride E-M with a 5% penalty.

Team Members will ride in different pools, if need be, as determined by the show holder.

Entries will be restricted to a practical number and preference will be given to Team Riders.

DEBUTANTE ARENA

Recreational classes 60cm-90cm, graded 90cm junior & adult, Pony Rider 80cm-1.15cm Show Jumping classes
Each grade will have an A2 speed class, and a Triple P Winter Classic

JANE LATIMER ARENA

Graded classes from 1m to 1.35m (juniors) & 1.40m (adults).

Each grade will have an A2 speed class, and a Triple P Winter Classic.

The 2022 ATHOL MCLEOD JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP (FEI ARTICLE 238.2.2) will be incorporated into the Junior 1.30/1.35m Triple P Winter Classic. The highest placed 1.30m Junior Rider & horse will be presented with this trophy. The overall winner of the class will be presented with the B'Lieu Triple P Winter Classic Floating trophy.

All Triple P Winter Classic classes have beautiful floating trophies that will be presented to the winners, and each winning rider will also be given a winner's sash. Grooms of winning horses/ponies will also be given prizes, and should accompany the winning rider into the prize giving.

Affiliated to SASJ – Recreational - therefore not graded.

There will be 2 identical tracks – with height differences – see the note below.

KZN Team Showjumping Trophy and Special Rosettes

Rule: 1st round Precision to be ridden by all team members; 2nd round Speed to be ridden by any 2 nominated team members, under Table A rules
Penalties from the 1st round will be carried forward.
Horses eliminated in the 1st round will go forward to the 2nd round but will carry maximum penalties.
Should there be equality of penalties and time, after round two, one member of each team will jump off against the clock.

NOTE: 2 parallel tracks will be built for the Team Show Jumping. One track at max. 0.90m and the other at +/- 1.10m – at the discretion of the course builder.
All horses graded 1.10m and up will be required to jump the higher track.
