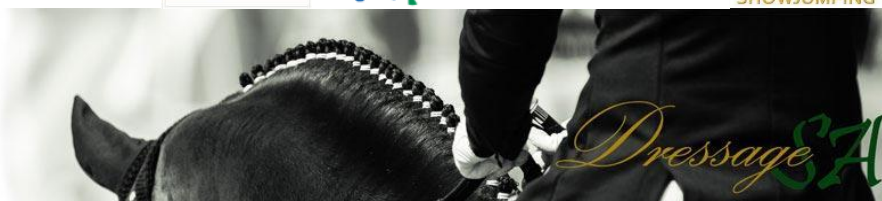

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. This show will be run under the rules of SAEF, SASA, DSA, SASJ, SAEQA and the Grahamstown Riding Club, and all relevant rules and regulations apply.
2. The SAEF, SASA, DSA, SAEQA and SASJ levies have been included in the entry fee and are detailed in the schedule.
3. Results for graded classes will count for grading points, subject to the approval of the relevant SAEF Official.
4. All riders are to wear protective headgear on the show grounds. Children and Juniors are to wear correct restraining harness on hat as stated in rule 12.2.2.
5. SAEF, SASA, DSA, SAEQA, SASJ, GRC and Show Organizers will not accept responsibility for any loss of property, damage or injury sustained by owners, competitors, and members of the public or any other person or their property at the Grahamstown Riding Club for the duration of the Show.
6. The owner of any dog not on a leash will be fined.
7. No late entries or entries without proof of payment will be accepted.
8. Entries without valid FLU and AHS details won't be accepted.
9. It is the competitor's responsibility to check whether their entries have been received.
10. This is a multi-discipline show, and we will make all efforts to ensure classes don't clash, but if it is impossible, competitors will have to choose which classes they will be competing in.
- 11. No refund will be given after the closing date of entries if a competitor scratches for whatever reason. If you have entered this show and scratch your entry after closing date, you will still be liable to pay your fees.**
12. By entering a stallion at the GRC, the competitor and owner agree to the following conditions and agree to abide by the following protocols:
 - a. Competition stallions always remain the responsibility of the owner and rider, and they are expected to have public liability against any loss, injury or damage that might be caused by the stallion.
 - b. It is the responsibility of the owner and rider to ensure that the stallion cannot exit the stable allocated to it on its own/or with the help of another horse or uninformed person.
 - c. The stallion may only be removed from the stable during the show for exercise and preparation/competition and only in the presence of a responsible handler or rider.
 - d. Under NO circumstances shall the covering of mares be allowed to take place at the GRC premises.
 - e. All stallions must always wear a yellow tag on their bridles.
13. Junior and Adult classes may be combined if entries are insufficient to hold the classes individually. In showing and dressage classes, separate prizes will be awarded for Juniors and Adults.
14. The program appearing in this schedule is STRICTLY PROVISIONAL and may change once all entries are received. Competitors are urged not to enter classes based purely on provisional program times.
15. Prize money awarded will only be done so for GRADED classes.

DRESSAGE

All entries must be done online on DSA. Stable bookings to be done via the [stable booking form](#).

All fees must be paid to the Grahamstown Riding Club

GENERAL

All graded (competitive category of membership) riders and their horses must be registered with DSA, SAEF and a DSA affiliated club. Adult competitive riders pay a membership fee. Performance history is recorded, and grading points earned at all levels for competitive riders.

Ungraded riders may compete up to and including Novice level. Ungraded adult members pay a reduced membership fee. Ungraded pony, child and junior riders must be registered but do not pay a membership fee. All horses and ponies must be registered with DSA.

Please note that there are new dressage tests for 2024, which are available to members for download on the DSA website (www.dressagesa.com). Tests are the same for all age groups. All tests to be ridden in a 20x60 arena, except children and pony riders' Prelim and Novice Tests, which are to be ridden in a 20x40 arena. Adult and Junior Prelim are to be ridden in a 20x60 arena.

Showing will be run under the auspices of the Showing Association of South Africa. SASA Show Rules edition 24 effective 1st January 2024 will apply.

1. All competitors (riders, owners and horses) in GRADED OPEN and NOVICE classes have to be registered with a recognized club, SAEF and SASA, or must pay temporary membership fee of R100 with their entry fee. Temporary members will not earn grading or Victor Ludorum points. Membership forms may be obtained on the SASA website, www.showingsa.co.za or from admin@showingsa.co.za.
2. No membership is required to enter the SASA Riding Horse Classes, unless earning points for the National Victor Ludorum's. All competitors must, however, be registered with SAEF. SAEF entry level membership for SASA riding horse is free of charge.
3. SASA will pay entry fees for SASA EDTS competitors in all classes. That includes in-hand and under saddle classes. The competitor must be an EDTS member of SASA. Membership is free. EDTS application forms, rules and conditions are available at www.showingsa.co.za or from admin@showingsa.co.za. EDTS members will earn EDTS Victor Ludorum points.
4. Registered SASA Instructors will earn National Instructors Victor Ludorum points.
