



GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Payments:

Email to georgeridingclub@gmail.com by entry closing date, failing which the entry will not be processed.

2. Horse flu and AHS vaccinations:

- No horse may enter the show without up-to-date horse flu and AHS vaccinations,
- Complete date & batch number on entry form.

3. Horses with infectious diseases.

• The competitor undertakes not to bring any horse or person to the show that has an infectious disease, whether notifiable or not.

4. Cancellations and scratching after closing date of entries:

NO refunds will be made in respect of cancellations and scratching after closing date of entries.

5. Discretion to cancel classes:

• The Organizing Committee reserves the rights to combine, vary, divide, or cancel classes if insufficient entries are received.

6. Changing of program and conditions:

- As far as possible, the program and conditions relating thereto will be adhered to.
- The Organizing Committee reserves the right to make alterations in the event of:
 - Unfavorable weather conditions or any other unforeseen circumstances
- Should the show be cancelled for any reason only 80% of entry fees will be refunded.



7. Indemnity:

None of the following organizers or officials by these organizes can be held responsible in any way for damage, loss, injury sustained by owners, competitors, or members of the public or another other people for the duration of a show at the George riding Show:

SAEF, the DSA, SASJ, SASA & SAEQA & the GRC,

8. Rules for Stallions:

- By entering a stallion, the competitor & owner agree to the following conditions & agree to abide by the following protocol:
 - Competition stallions remain the responsibility of the owner & rider at all times & they are expected to have public liability against any loss, injury or damage that might be caused by the stallion.
 - o It is the responsibility of the owner & rider to ensure that the stallion cannot exit the stable allocated to it on its own/or with the help of another horse or uninformed person.
 - The stallion may only be removed from the stable during the show for exercise & preparation/competition & only in the presence of a responsible handler or rider.
 - Under NO circumstances shall the covering of mares be allowed to take place at the GRC premises.
 - Stallions to always wear a yellow tag.
 - o Passports that include a valid Height Certificate must be available at show.

9. Registration with SAEF

- All competitors must be registered with SAEF.
- Organizers reserve the right to fine, warn, suspend and/or eliminate any rider that does not abide by the SAEF rules.

10. Incomplete entries and entries without proof of payment:

- Incomplete entries/ entries without payment will be excluded.
- Riders will still be liable for entry fees if entries are not deleted before close of entries.
- 11. Rules regarding excessive use of whips will be enforced.
- 12. Interference with decisions of Judges, Stewards or Officials
 - Any person who attempts to interfere with or influence the Judges, Stewards or Officials, or who at any time uses any
 contemptuous or abusive language to any of the Officials may forfeit his/her rights to any prizes to which they might
 otherwise be entitled and may face other disciplinary actions.

- 14. Hard Hats always to be worn on GRC Ground when mounted.
- 15. Right of Admission to GRC Grounds is Reserved



The event will be run under SASA and SAEF rules unless otherwise stated.

- 1. Competitors may only ride one horse in each class, except in the Working Classes, where they may ride up to three horses.
- 2. All Riders and Horses must be registered with a Club, SAEF and SASA. Membership forms may be obtained on the SASA website www.showingsa.co.za or from admin@showingsa.co.za. Temporary SASA Membership of R115
- 3. SASA will pay entry fees for SASA EDTS competitors in all classes. That includes In Hand and Under Saddle classes. The competitor must be an EDTS member of SASA. Membership is free. EDTS application forms, Rules and Conditions are available at www.showingsa.co.za or from admin@showingsa.co.za EDTS competitors will earn EDTS Victor Ludorum points.
- 4. Working Hunters will be required to jump a course of approximately 8-12 fences, one of which will be a combination.
- 5. Should a competitor qualify more than one horse for the championship, he may nominate another rider, who must be a paid-up member of SASA, to show the horse in that championship. However, the competitor must do the individual test required in the Championship.
- 6. All classes will be run under SASA Rules Edition 25 effective 1st January 2025
- 7. EVERY COMPETITOR ENTERING THIS SHOW DOES HEREBY INDEMNIFY ANY JUDGE REGISTERED WITH SASA, OFFICIATING AT THIS SHOW, AGAINST ANY CLAIM OF ANY NATURE FROM ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER.
- 8. Registered SASA Instructors will earn Victor Ludorum points for pupils.
- 9. Open Horses may be ridden by the Judge
- 10. Heights of Horses and Ponies must be stated in the SASA passport.
- 11. The minimum age of horses shown under saddle shall be 3 years.
- 12. All competitors, owners and sponsors shall be registered with a club in whose area of jurisdiction they have their principal place of residence, SAEF and SASA and shall be re-registered on 1 January each year. Membership forms may be obtained on the SASA website www.showingsa.co.za or from admin@showingsa.co.za
- 13. Horses shall be registered with SAEF and SASA.
- 14. The horse and rider combination will compete as a member of the province where the rider is resident.
- 15. On no account, and under penalty of disqualification, may any horse take part in any of the showing classes if the horse has been ridden by anyone other than the competitor or judge from the first day of the show until the end of the last class in which that horse competes.
- 16. A deposit of R20 for a number is included in the entry fee.
