Entry fees:	Equitation – Intro class R400, welcome R450, novice to open R500.00 - all per horse, per class Entry fee includes arena Levy R80.00, R30.00 Official's Levy, R30.00 Medical & Security levy, and R5.00 Course Builders Levy. SAEQA R15 provincial levy and R20 national levy, except for Welcome and Intro classes which are R15 only Entry fees Include portion of R1750/day per Paramedic levy, and all applicable discipline levies. <b>Team Entry: R1000 per team – to be entered on a team entry form signed &amp; stamped by school</b>

**Notes:** This Interschools competition is in no way linked or affiliated to SANESA Schools.

- The organizers reserve the right to cancel, combine, limit or divide classes if necessary and if number of entries do not warrant the running of the class, so long as this does not affect team riders. In addition, the organizers reserve the right to change arenas should conditions or entries warrant the change.
- N.B: SUBSTITUTIONS OF HORSE OR RIDER HAVE TO BE COMPLETED AND SIGNED 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO START OF THE CLASS.
- Should the Substitution be Horse AND rider, Substitution Form has to be signed by both old and new competitor and Substitution Form received by show holder 24 hours prior to the start of the show.
- All horses/ponies and riders must be registered with SAEF.
- Entries out of order by closing date will be forfeit.
- Should the show need to be postponed due to weather or unforeseen circumstances, all entries will be carried forward to a new date. Should the show be cancelled for circumstances beyond the organizer's control, entries will be refunded less 20% admin fee
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**INDIVIDUALS RIDING FOR SCHOOL TEAMS:** Competitors participating in the School Show Jumping Teams must enter & pay individually – there are individual prizes as well as the team awards.

**PONY RIDERS:** Pony riders wishing to compete on their ponies for their High School may do so as long as the Rider is a registered learner in their High School i.e. Grade 8 and above.

**Equitation:** We have Pony Riders and Junior classes – the team riders in these individual classes will have their scores put forward as per special rules to their nominated Team's score. If you are not a registered member of Equitation SA you may pay the required Temporary Membership Fee – R50 – but you must still register online at [www.saeqa.co.za](http://www.saeqa.co.za).

**No Adult may ride any Junior/Pony Rider horse/pony entered in the show from one hour prior to the first class of the show until the end of the team jumping under penalty of elimination. (except in the case of a school pupil who is registered as an adult competitor riding their own horse)**

### **GENERAL RULES FOR SCHOOL TEAMS:**

1. ALL Riders & Horses nominated to ride in a School Show Jumping Team MUST compete in at least one of the Individual show jumping classes.
2. ALL Riders representing their school in a school team must be pupils of the High School Section of their School. This is not a show for Junior School Pupils. i.e. only Pupils registered in Grade 8 or above may be part of the school's teams..
3. All teams are to be nominated & entered on the special Team Entry Form, signed and stamped by the Principal or person designated by the School. Competitors participating in School Teams must enter on both the Team & Individual Entry forms.
4. A Team shall consist of 4 riders/4 horses provided they are all pupils of the same High School. Or a minimum of 3 riders/3 horses from the same school. The best 3 scores will count towards the Team Results in all disciplines

5. Only one horse per rider per team (school) per discipline will be allowed. Each rider may only represent their school once in each discipline (ie you may not ride two horses in one or two teams)
6. Schools may combine, provided they do not have 4 riders of a suitable level at the discipline in any one School. A combined School Team may consist of 3 or 4 riders.  
All Equitation Teams must have their final team confirmation by 07h45 on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> March Box - failing which the original School Entry will be accepted to be correct.
7. A School entering two or more teams please note: If a horse/rider in a Team is unable to compete, the 4<sup>th</sup> rider/horse from either of the Teams may change Teams. The change of rider/horse must be nominated 1 hour prior to the start of the event. Each rider may only represent their school once in each discipline – they cannot ride one horse in the A team, and another in the B team.

An additional 3 points for Open and 2 points for Intermediate per rider will be added to the final score of part 1 & part 2 for the Team Riders. Riders must enter the grade they have been competing in. (To be filled in on school team entry form as well))

**There will be individual prizes for all classes – prize givings after the classes. Grooms of winning horses/ponies will be given prizes, and should accompany the winning rider into the prize giving ceremonies.**
